Enjoy The Scenery of Mt. Fuji from The Boat! 【Hakone Pirate Ship Cruise】

It takes around 25 mins from Motohakone Port to Togendai Port. About 25 minutes from Motohakone Port to Togendai Port. The Hakone Pirate Ship was modeled after an 18th-century British sailing battleship. The observation deck has a 360-degree view. The scenery of Hakone, which can only be seen from the lake, is stunning. Indulge yourself in the sight of the red torii gate, Mt. Fuji, and the Hakone Lake from the pirate ship while feeling a pleasant breeze.



Picturesque Scenery From 130m Above The Ground! 【Hakone Ropeway・Owakudani】

Get ready to be amazed by your surrounding during this 30-minute ropeway ride from Togendai to Owakudani. On the Ropeway, you can enjoy the powerful scenery from each season of Owakudani, Mt. Fuji, and Lake Ashinoko, which you should see at least once. Owakudani, was known as Jigokudani (Hell Valley) because of its devastated ground and volcanic smoke, and the smell of sulfur creates an overwhelming presence. One of its specialties is the Black Eggs boiled in a hot spring pond, making them perfect as souvenirs.



The World Heritage Site 【Mt. Fuji】

Standing at 3776 meters, Mt. Fuji is the highest peak in Japan and is an active volcano that straddles Shizuoka and Yamanashi prefectures. Its elegant appearance is widely known worldwide as the symbol of Japan. In addition, it has been the subject of many works of art and has had a significant impact not only on the artistic side but also on the geology, such as the climate and strata. Immerse yourself in the majestic view of the Fuji Five Lakes and the Japanese Alps spreading out below from the viewing spot at the 5th Station of the Fuji Subaru Line (altitude 2,305m).
